

Practical Information

Bruce Springsteen and the E Street Band 8. July 2009

Please leave plenty of time to get to the concert arena. At the latest plan to arrive 45 minutes before the concert begins.

- The arena opens at 6pm
- The concert starts at 8pm

Body search:

It is not allowed to bring the following objects into MCH Outdoor Arena:

- Professional camera/ photo equipment (with large lenses)
- Video- or sound-recorders
- Umbrellas
- Flags, banners, signs etc.
- Weapons of any kind
- Fireworks and the like
- Food and drinks
- Bottles or cans
- Chairs and stools – in either seating or standing areas

Parking:

MCH has over 12.000 parking spaces at the concert. All spaces are in the immediate vicinity of MCH Outdoor Arena, the furthest being 12 minutes by foot from the arena. The police local defence volunteers will direct the traffic to the parking areas, where parking attendants will show the cars to their designated areas.

Meeting Points:

At MCH Outdoor Arena there are two meeting points, which are easy to locate. Keep your eye out for the red or black balloon – see overview map.

Cloakroom:

There are cloakrooms at every entrance AB – CDHJ – EFG. The cloakroom is free of charge and at your own risk. 1 person will man the cloakroom during the concert.

Information:

There are Information stands at every entrance AB – CDHJ – EFG.

Lost objects can be picked up at the Information stand by entrance CDHJ.

Cash and Cash points:

We encourage people to bring cash, but it is possible to take out cash by the red and black meeting points – see the map.

First aid:

In the unlikely event of any emergency, first-aiders will be on site to handle cases. See map for positions or contact the nearest member of staff.

Food and drink:

The Outdoor Arena area opens at 6pm and you can buy food and drinks such as: Burgers, hot dogs, sandwiches, sushi, churros, popcorn, crisps and a large variety of drinks.

Overview map of the area:

At every entrance and exit you will find detailed maps of the area.

Walking route:

Avoid the traffic – enjoy the scenic walking route from the centre of Herning/Train station/Bus station via Chr. Ydesvej to MCH Outdoor Arena. The route is around 2km long (about 25 minutes walk) – and there are toilets en route!

After the concert:

After the concert you can keep partying, as the centre of Herning is open till late and ready for visitors. A special outdoor After Party by Herning Kongrescenter will go on till 2 am with music and festivities.
